Is it possible to give God our minds?
I believe that it is. Is it easy?
No it is not easy, nor should it be!
Why? Because God does not want robots;
mindless machines.

True worship is God directed, 'I look to the heavens and then man directed,' the vertical and the horizontal, making the shape of the cross. My attitude towards God and my attitude towards my fellow man are important. In fact my attitude towards God will influence my attitude towards my fellow human beings: I believe that the worship of God leads us into depths of relationship, not only with God but each other as the body of Christ. I do not believe that relationships should be forced, but I do believe that they are something that we work on. Romans 12 is about the wonderful dynamic that there should be within the life of the Church- true fellowship with God produces true fellowship within the church: For the basis of the true fellowship is the worship of God and grasping the love of God that is released in our hearts by the Holy Spirit. Fellowship is a Two Way Street: any good relationship means that one works at getting to know that person and getting to know someone takes time and effort. One of the mysteries and blessings of being part of the church of the Lord Jesus is the fact that we are all different, with different likes and dislikes, different personalities and even different political views. My experience has been that the Holy Spirit will led us into relationships. My dedication to God impacts my relationship with others. Romans chapter 12 gives us insight into true worship and true fellowship. What does it mean; "to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice". In the first century there were those who taught that 'the body was only a prison house, something to be despised and even be ashamed of.' [Barclay p156] Frail though we might be, and maybe riddled with disease and decay- our bodies make up part of who we are and it is with the whole of our being that we worship God. Body, Mind and Spirit. The Lord Jesus put it this way: 30 Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength." Mark 12:30 We all face the reality and restrictions of our humanity, our bodies and circumstances- even these can be subject to the Lordship of Christ. The whole of our being IS service and worship. 21 For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain. Philippians 1:20,21

Moving onto verse 2: Is it possible to give God our minds? I believe that it is. Is it easy? No it is not! Nor should it be! Why? Because God does not want robots mindless machines. I have always wondered what it would be like to have the power to inject people with a dose of faith, and a dose of the gifts and fruit of the Spirit. Image walking out of church on a Sunday and being injected with a dose of these things, whether we like it or not! If I had the power to make you believe what I believe, to be the sort of person I wanted you to be and so on. What would happen to the person God created? I believe that each of us is precious in God's sight, each one of us is unique. God in His wisdom has given us the freedom to make spiritual and physical choices. Thus the struggle and battle for the mind; we think that we think, yet we are influenced by so many things- they are not all that good for us. I believe that there is a battle for the mind; I also believe that we should allow God to win it!

"God transforms our minds and makes us spiritually minded by using His Word. As you spend time meditating on God's Word, memorizing it and making it a part of your inner man, God will gradually make your mind more spiritual."
