Sincerity is not enough. The scriptures teach us that no one can work their way to heaven, and it is possible that an individual, a group of people, a movement and a nation can get it wrongeven with the best of intentions. It is not till the truth is pointed out; our being saved through the Lord Jesus dying for our sins and us responding to Him. The truths of Romans 10, give us a unique insight into the mind of the Apostle Paul.

Paul teaches he does not do things on his own authority. He doesn't pick out random ideas and present them in this short chapter. Paul quotes from the Old Testament at least 12 times. More than half of this chapter is made up of Old Testament quotes, i.e. the practical working out of the Old Testament teaching from the perspective of one of the masters of the Christian faith.

<u>Chapter 10</u> is one of 16 fact filled chapters in a wonderful theological masterpiece.

Sincerity is not enough! The scriptures teach us that no one can work their way to heaven, and it is possible that an individual, a group of people, a movement and a nation can get it wrong- even with the best of intentions. It is not till the truth is pointed out that one can respond to that truth.

The Bible says that we reap what we sow and God will not be mocked or fooled!

It is when we hear the truth in clarity that we must respond and change our ways- this was Paul's dilemma with the nation of Israel, we wanted them so much to see the truth of the Lord Jesus and respond.

The good news is that many did. <u>Acts 6:7</u> *"And the word of God continued to increase, and the number of the disciples multiplied greatly in Jerusalem, and <u>a great many of the priests became obedient to the faith."*</u>

For Paul the concept of being saved was paramount- He was a Jew, he loved his people and rightly so. He also knew that they had got it wrong; all the best intentions under the sun were not good enough.

He writes:- Brothers and sisters, my heart's desire and prayer to God for the Israelites is that they may be saved.² For I can testify about them that they are zealous for God, but their zeal is not based on knowledge. ³ Since they did not know the righteousness of God and sought to establish their own, they did not submit to God's righteousness. ⁴ Christ is the culmination of the law so that there may be righteousness for everyone who believes.

- His heart's desire is that His people may be saved.
- He acknowledges that they were zealous for God.
- This zeal was based on their own works and knowledge.
- Salvation is the product of God's righteousness not ours.
- All that they were taught throughout the centuries was pointing to the Lord Jesus- the Christ!

Five basic truths! They were relevant then and they are just as relevant now!
