## 'Has God Got your attention?'

God's presence in our lives should:

Excite and provoke us to service.

Enthuse and spur us to action.

Encourage and motivate us to give thanks





Last Sunday I finished with the question; 'Has God Got your attention?'. It was obvious that He got the attention of the lame man at the temple gate, also the crowd that scrambled to hear and see what the commotion was about.

Also, God's presence in our lives should:

Excite and provoke us to service.

Enthuse and spur us to action.

Encourage and motivate us to thanksgiving.

There are miracles happening every day of our lives. A miracle is something that works outside the natural. I often find myself praying that God would do something wonderful in a person's life, asking for a miracle, a special healing, the turning of the tide in an individual's life; something that would not normally happen if things were left to their own devices.

It is obvious the disciples were excited, enthused and encouraged. We also can see that they were energised by the Holy Spirit. There was a boldness and for some a fearlessness in the expression of their faith. There was also a sense of urgency as if they were the only ones who had the message of salvation. A message that all should hear: a message that demands a response from those who heard it.

Acts 3: Don't look at us, says Peter, this is God's doing! Peter wanted the crowd to understand that what had happened could only be attributed to God. It was not the power of Peter and John. He also makes it very clear that whatever faith this man had it came from the Lord Jesus.

In Verse 16,THREE things are evident:

- 1. The lame man had to acknowledge the Lord Jesus,
- 2. He also had to exercise personal faith in the Lord Jesus,
- 3. It is the Lord Jesus who takes that small seed of faith and turns it into something beautiful and something good

I love that! It doesn't completely depend on me; it is the Lord Jesus's name and the faith that comes through Him. I am forgiven; I am saved, yes even healed, not because of the preacher, or my will power or faith, but because of the Lord Jesus.

It is when we rely on these things, the externals, our circumstances, others and the trappings around us that we can be so easily led astray and distracted.

The cross was their answer, the ultimate rejection of God's plan-THE EMPTY TOMB WAS GOD'S REMEDY and RESPONSE TO THEIR REBELION.

This healing was proof that the Lord Jesus was alive. In such a public place, in such a dramatic way! God got their attention. Has God got your attention?
