The Lord Jesus gave priority to prayer in His life.

"Prayer is the expression of the human heart in conversation with God "

Prayer is the means that God has provided for us to unburden to Him our desires.

Prayer is the surrendering of our minds "Not My will be done" Prayer is being with God, not a word needs to be said.

Prayer is conversation with God. Good conversation is two way.

The Holy Spirit is present to assist us.
