God's glory is such a huge topic to understand. We struggle to comprehend the vastness of God and His revealed glory.

Exodus 40:34-38 At the tent of meeting God's glory in the cloud and fire was a graphic demonstration of His presence and yet at times the people struggled to comprehend the God who desired relationship with them.

In Scripture down through history God portrays His glory as He progressively unfolds His glory in His creation (Romans 1:20) and through His people.

Genesis 17 God's promises to Abraham and the outworking of those promises through key players, like Moses, David, Isaiah, and many others, all record the desire God has to impact the universe with His glory.

As Jesus Christ comes to earth (John 1:14) it is clear that the promise given to Moses in Deuteronomy 18:18 was about to be fulfilled. John 17:8 leaves us in no doubt as to what the mission of Jesus is about. From the words of Jesus we see His desire to do His Father's will. The challenges are many when it comes to keeping our focus on God's glory. Here are a few tips:

Having a daily time of reading God's word.

Having a daily time of prayer to connect with God's glory.

Having regular fellowship with God's people to embrace God's glory together.
