Wendy was thrilled to see this writing in the sky near her home on Easter Sunday! This past couple of weeks I have prepared and presented three video sermons. I was intrigued to see that one of the messages had over 130 hits on the internet. Times have dictated that we do things differently for a season. I was speaking to another pastor this week and he tells me that a number of his congregation have come back to the fold, strange because like us they are no longer able to hold church services. All that they do has been done online, some pre-recorded and some live streamed. I struggled with the dilemma, to do or not to do? There is so much out there, some of it is exceptional both in presentation and in teaching. After much thought and prayer, I concluded that we too should be out there. I already do a radio programme so how hard would it be to do a video presentation? Much harder actually, what a learning curve!

It has been a good discipline and if I am able, I will endeavour to keep up the effort. Again, I ask myself why? Is it ego? Is it about the preacher and the preaching? No, it is not! I am stirred by my personal walk with the Lord and for me what I do is an element of my personal devotions. My prayer is that it will be of benefit to others and a blessing to the overall ministry of the Wollongong Congregational Church.

Years ago I read, 'Practicing the presence of God' and was challenged by the authors walk with the Lord. Brother Lawrence was a poor dishwasher and cook in a 17th-century French monastery. During his 40 years as a monk, he came to a deep understanding of what it meant to practice the presence of God. He wrote that he came to the point of always "keeping [his] mind in His holy presence, and when tempted to change his thoughts he would come back to this thought. God is always present.

I know that we are not monks living in the 17th Century nor do we live in a monastery. We inhabit the 21st Century and have different vocations, although at present many are in social isolation. So whether working from home or forced to spend time with family, we can 'practice the presence of God' in our lives.

Ponder on these ongoing practices—not as over-and-done actions.

Abide (John 15:4–5) Love God and neighbour (Matthew 22:37–40) Set your mind (Romans 8:5–6) Walk /keep in step with the Spirit (Galatians 5:16, 25) Set your heart (Colossians 3:1–2) Rejoice always (1 Thessalonians 5:16) Pray continually (1 Thessalonians 5:17) Give thanks in all circumstances (1 Thessalonians 5:18) Run with endurance/perseverance (Hebrews 12:1–2) Submit/offer yourself up (Romans 12:1–2) Press on (Philippians 3:12–14) Dwell on (Philippians 4:6–8) Remember God's faithfulness and provision (Deuteronomy 8:2–3) God's richest blessings to you all.
